 - Is my study gathering qualitative or quantitative data?
 - Is it experimental, non-experimental, or quasi-experimental?
- Is my method well-aligned to the purpose of my study and my RQ?
 - Name your method.
 - Can I defend my choice of methods with explanations and evidence?
 - Is there something in the documents about methods that I can use to support my choice?
 - Is there another study that uses my tools or method?
 - If I've made changes to the established tools or methods, what reasons am I giving?
- What was my step-by-step process for collecting my data?
 - Why did I choose this process?
 - What are the limitations of my method?
 - What are the benefits of this method?
